AN OVERVIEW

Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Institute of Medical Sciences is centrally located in Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. The hospital affiliated to the institute offers high end services and treatment in various broad and Superspeciality medical disciplines and also offers teaching facilities for imparting degrees of D.M., M.Ch., M.D., M.S., DNB as well as PDCC & PDF in academic residency programs. Residents in academic courses as well as residents not formally registered for an academic program are responsible for teaching and hospital services as well as any work assigned from time to time by the institute authorities.

The hospital serves as a referral centre for the population of Lucknow, adjacent districts, belt of Eastern U.P and nearby states. Facilities are extended to all sections of society including the poor and low resource population of this region who require specialized care.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nationality: Only Indian nationals are eligible to apply.

Essential Educational Qualifications

Candidates must possess a requisite qualification **RECOGNISED** by the **NMC erstwhile Medical Council of India /NBE before the last date for submission of applications** (except for degrees not covered by Medical Council of India, where the degrees must be recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses).

Final year appearing candidates may also apply in their respective specialty. However, at the time of joining, passing Degree certificate with registration from the recognized body will be required to be submitted, failing which candidate(s) will not be permitted to join and offer of appointment letter will be cancelled.

Upper Age: Upper age limit for eligibility of PDCC is 45 years as reckoned on Last date of online application.

Application Fee:-(Non-refundable): Payable online as per instructions given in the advertisement.

The application fee for the post of PDCC is Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only (including GST). Additional Bank transaction charge may apply.

- Application fee is non-refundable either in full or in part under any circumstances.
- Applications without the prescribed fee would not be considered and summarily rejected.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Important Instructions:

1. Candidates who are serving in any college/ institution/ hospital as full-time/ part-time/ under service bond/ etc. shall obtain a No Objection Certificate from the appropriate authority for application. Their candidature would be rejected if the candidate is unable to produce NOC/ Relieving from appropriate authority.
2. If, at any stage, any desired/necessary information is suppressed or misrepresented by the Candidate, his/her candidature can be cancelled and other appropriate action like countervailing etc. can be initiated against him/her.
3. Candidates will have to produce hard copy of their online application, original copies of all certificates in support of all the claims made regarding their candidature in the application and self-attested copies of their certificates, as per the instructions of the institute at the time of interview and/or counselling. The candidates shortlisted based on written examination will be informed separately by the institute.
4. Candidates are directed to preserve the information (in the form of soft and hard copy for future reference) rendered at each step of registration/ application (eg- registration, fee payment, final submit etc.) while applying online.

5. On-line Application: For online application, candidates will have to provide their mobile number and valid e-mail ID in the prescribed columns, without which their basic registration will not be completed. All the information/instructions will be sent on this mobile number/e-mail id in future.

Detailed instructions for filling application form on-line:

Online link for filling up the online application form will be displayed on the institute website www.drrmlims.ac.in. The last date of filling up online application form **will be 21 days from the start of online application till 05.00 PM.**

Filling the application form:

1. Open the home page of Dr RMLIMS, Lucknow at <https://drrmlims.ac.in>.
2. On the Home page, click on the link that announces the advertisement for recruitment.
3. Click tab on the "Online form submission" and for **Registration** of filling the form.

The following steps are required to fill up the on-line application form: -

Step - 1

- Please read all details of advertisement, general instructions carefully before applying.
- Please use this step to give general information about yourself for Registration.
- For registration, you need to have a valid Mobile Number & Email Address.
- Candidates can edit filled details any time before submitting, except Basic Details (First Page).
- After entering the required information in On-line form, submit the form by clicking on SUBMIT button.
- A SMS containing application number and login ID information will be forwarded at your registered Mobile Number / Email Address.
- Note: Please note down the application number carefully as you need to essentially mention it in all your future correspondence / queries related to your application form.

Step - 2

- Fill all the required fields in the Registration form.
- Fill educational qualification, experience, date of birth & other details prescribed for applied position.
- Upload Passport size Photograph: - (jpg or png, maximum 1 MB). The photograph must be taken against a light and clear background.
- Upload Signature: - (jpg or png, maximum 1 MB). The signature must be in bold black colour on white paper.
- Upload all documents pertaining to qualification, experience, cast etc. (where ever applicable).
- After click on preview & submit button, you will be redirected to preview application page.
- After submission on on-line application, candidates are required to pay Application Fee mandatorily (wherever applicable). Non-submission of application fee or submitting wrong amount would lead to rejection of application.

Step – 3

- Click on Proceed to payment button to complete your payment (if applicable) after filling the application form.
- If after the payment of the Fee (e-payment), the candidate is not sure whether the payment is processed or not, then please use login tab to enter in your login account and use check your previous transaction status option to check whether your payment was successful.
- Download and retain a copy of on-line application form for future reference.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded in any case.

Check List:

- a) Please complete and arrange your application for future references. (No forms or documents need to be sent to the Institute)
- b) A self-certified copy of matriculation / age proof certificate.
- c) Proof of MD / MS / DNB/DM /.MCh/DNB SS course recognized by National Medical Commission of India / State Medical Council and a self – certified NMC recognized MD/MS/DNB/DM/MCh/DNB SS Degree / passing certificate. Qualifications from programs where recognition is pending / in process WILL NOT be entertained and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- d) Candidate with medical degree must submit copies MBBS Medical Registration from NMC or State Medical Council and also registration of MD Degree with a council competent bodies.
- e) A 'NO Objection Certificate' from the current employer (when applicable).

STEPS AFTER SUBMITTING APPLICATION

Hall Ticket for Computer Based Test (CBT):

METHOD OF SELECTION :

The entrance examination will be conducted in two parts- A & B. Admission to Post Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC) will be on the basis of combined merit of the examination (Computer Based Test (Part- A)) and departmental assessment of Applied/ Practical/ Clinical aspects of the Subject knowledge (Offline (Part-B)) in respective department as per the availability of the specialty courses **on 29/01/2024 after the declaration of result of part-A on 28/01/2024. Only the candidates qualifying for Part-A will be considered for the part-B examination and final merit.**

- **No Negative marking.**
- In case of tie of candidates securing identical total marks, the candidate with higher marks in Part-B will be ranked higher and if marks in Part-B are also identical, then the older candidate will be ranked higher.

STEPS AFTER SELECTION

Medical examination

No candidate will be permitted to join a course / post, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. With holding information about current or past illness /treatment if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action that may include termination of appointment at any stage.

Joining

If a candidate fails to join the PDCC Courses by the date stipulated in the offer of appointment letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

Duties and responsibilities

Students admitted to PDCC courses shall simultaneously work as Senior Residents. They will be required to perform such work as may be assigned to them and is necessary in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in emergency services as and when required.

Duration of PDC Course: One Year

Salary:

The salary of PDC Course candidates will be equivalent to first year Senior Resident admissible in the Institute.

Hostel accommodation

Accommodation may be provided in the campus, if available.

MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS

The date, time and venue of examination will be provided on the admit card.

- No TA/DA shall be paid for appearing in the entrance examination or for joining.
- The number of seats/posts advertised may increase / decrease.
- Number of seats/posts indicated in the advertisement for various programs is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- Any attempt on the part of a candidate to suppress facts, to provide false information or to influence selection directly or indirectly will be treated as a disqualification. If evidence of this surfaces after selection, the services may be terminated and admission cancelled, even at that stage.
- Each selected candidate shall have to pay the fee/dues within the prescribed period, failing which his /her admission/appointment shall be cancelled.
- The selected candidates shall need to have present original documents (medical registration, date of birth certificate, certificates of educational qualification, experience and relieving and good conduct certificate from the University/Institution last attended) for inspection and verification by the Institute authorities and submit a self-attested copy of each at the time of joining.
- Qualifications from programs where recognition is pending/ in process will NOT be entertained and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Applicants must possess the eligibility degree/ pass certificate before application.
- The training programs are full-time and continuous, and private practice in any form after joining the Institute is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this may leave to termination of appointment and cancellation of admission.
- Those who work in departments where there is potential for radiation exposure, shall be compulsorily required to abide by the rules of the Institutes radiation safety cell, (in conformity with the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board guidelines).
- Senior Residents admitted to the Institute shall maintain good conduct, attend their classes regularly and abide by the regulations/guidelines of the Institute failing which their names are liable to be struck off the rolls of the Institute.

- Participation in any agitation, protest, strike, etc. is prohibited. Candidates not abiding with the supervisions are liable to be terminated.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the Institute.
- No intimation to non-selected candidates will be sent and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute, taken from time to time.
- The decisions taken by the Director of the Institute in all matters related to the selection of candidates for admission to various courses shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.

Force majeure

If the entrance examination is postponed or cancelled (in part or in full) due to any reason whatsoever beyond the control of the organizers (viz. elements of nature, force majeure or orders/directives issued by any competent government authority), the institute shall not be responsible for any loss or injury sustained by the candidates directly or indirectly.
