1 - ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1(a) Nationality

Only Indian Nationals are eligible.

1(b) Essential Educational Qualifications

Candidates must possess, as on 31st July, 2019 a requisite qualification **RECOGNISED** by the **Medical Council of India** (except for degrees not covered by Medical Council of India, where the degrees must be recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses). Postgraduate degrees from Departments / Institutions to which MCI recognition has not been formally granted (for example: under consideration) will not be considered and candidature of such applicants with such degrees may be rejected at any stage (including after admission if this fact comes to notice at that stage).

1 (c) Age

Upper age limit for eligibility is 37 years as reckoned on 31st July, 2019. Age relaxation to a maximum of

5 years may be given to SC/ST/OBC candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh, to widowed / divorced / legally-separated women who have not re-married and to disabled/handicapped persons, as per Government rules. Age relaxation will not be given for PDC course.

1(d) Reservation

For Senior Resident, reservation will apply as per UP Government rules. Only candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh will be eligible for the benefit of reservation. Reserved category candidates having domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as General category candidates for all purposes. Candidate applying under reserved category must possess valid and admissible caste certificate as per UP government rules.

2 - APPLICATION PROCEDURE

2 (a) Information brochure & Application form

The information brochure can be downloaded from the website www.drrmlims.com from 16th June 2019 onwards. The candidates should follow the instructions in the brochure carefully while filling up the form.

The candidates need to fill the application form online. Last date for submitting the online application forms will be 30th June 2019 failing which it is not possible to apply.

2 (b) Application fee

Non-Refundable Application Fee of INR 1000/- payable via the application web portal as specified in the instructions given in the online application form. Additional bank/ transaction charges may apply.

2 (c) Option for Post Doctoral Certificate Course (PDCC):

In the department of Pathology, there is an option for Post doctoral certificate course in Oncopathology along with Senior Residency. The admission to Post Doctoral Certificate Course will be on merit basis amongst the candidates opting for it; rest of the qualified candidates will be offered the post of Senior Resident. The question paper will be common to both, and candidates have a choice, as long as they fulfill the eligibility criteria.

3 - STEPS AFTER SUBMITTING APPLICATION

3 (a) How to know your eligibility

List of 'not eligible' candidates will be displayed on the website on **9th July, 2019**.

- **Important instruction: A applicant, who is found 'not eligible' for the entrance examination, may request for a review of his/her application to the Director of the Institute by 11th July, 2019 however no additional document or information other than that submitted with the original application form will be considered during such review. Request for review made after the above specified dates will not be considered.**

3(b) How to get your admit card

Eligible candidates can log in and print their Admit Card online from **12th July, 2019** onwards as per the instructions provided on the website. **Please note that Admit Card(s) will not be sent by post.**

3(c) Examination / Selection process

The recruitment test will have two parts:

Part A: Objective written examination of 90-minute duration, consisting of 80 multiple choice questions of equal marks for selection of Senior Residents & PDC Courses will be held in two batches on **Sunday 21st & Monday 22nd July, 2019** at 11.00 AM (**venue communicated in the admit card**). Candidates have to report well in time (by 8.30am on the day of examination) to the examination venue for Biometric registration before the test. No negative marking shall be there.

Part B (Departmental Practical assessment): Based on merit of Part A examination, short listed candidates will be called for Part B departmental practical assessment (generally in the ratio of 3 candidates per seat advertised, pooling all SR and PDC posts in each department), to be held on **25th July, 2019 in the respective departments in the institute.** The list of candidates called for departmental Practical assessment will be displayed on Wednesday, **24th July 2019,** on the website (www.drmlims.com).

- **Candidates shortlisted for Part B are required to download the admit card for Part B examinations from the website (www.drmlims.com).**

The Final result of selected candidates after pooling results of Part-A + B will be declared on **27th July, 2019** on the website (www.drmlims.com)

- **In case of 'Tie' the older candidate (earlier date of birth) is ranked above younger candidate.**

Marks obtained in Written/departmental Practical assessment will not be declared/ displayed. There is no provision for re-checking/re-evaluation and NO QUERY in this regard will be entertained.

- In case of any discrepancy observed in the date and time of the Recruitment Test mentioned in the Information brochure, Admit Card etc. candidates are required to contact the helpline number provided on the website.
- No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for the recruitment process.
- Number of seats/posts indicated in the advertisement for various programs is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- Any attempt on the part of a candidate to suppress facts, provide false information or influence selection directly or indirectly will be treated as a disqualification. If evidence of this surfaces after selection, the appointment/candidature may be terminated, even at any later stage.

4 -STEPS AFTER SELECTION

4 (a) Medical examination

No candidate will be permitted to join a course, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. Withholding information about current or past illness / treatment if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action that may include termination of appointment at any stage.

4 (b) Joining

If a candidate fails to join the senior residency / PDC Course by the date stipulated in the appointment /selection letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

4 (c) Duties and responsibilities

Students admitted to PDC courses shall simultaneously work as Senior Residents. They will be required to perform such work as may be assigned to them and is necessary in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in emergency services, as and when required.

4 (d) Duration of appointment

All Senior Residents are appointed for a maximum period of 3 years subject to renewal after satisfactory performance report from their departments at the end of every year. If a PDC student takes extraordinary leave or maternity leave for more than 3 months, the tenure of training will be extended by another six months with stipend and examination will be delayed as per the Institute rules in force from time to time. Appointment of PDC course student is for one year. **Since the total tenure of SR is 3 years, including any previous appointments as SR at DR.RMLIMS or elsewhere, the candidates are required to declare the period of training or service undertaken as Senior Resident at DR.RMLIMS or in other Institutions at the time of applying. Any failure to do so can lead to cancellation of candidature and even termination of appointment.**

5-EMOLUMENTS & ACCOMODATION

5 (a) Stipend

Senior Residents/PDCC candidates are paid Stipend of Rs.67700/ plus NPA (only for candidates with qualification of MBBS) plus other allowances, as per rules.

5(b) Hostel accommodation

The hostel accommodation will be provided **subject to availability**. However HRA is admissible in lieu of Hostel Accommodation.

5 (c) Leave entitlement

The leave is permissible to the Senior Residents /PDCC candidates as per prevailing rules of Dr. RMLIMS, Lucknow.

7- IMPORTANT POINTS/INSTRUCTIONS

- The selected candidates shall have to present following original documents for inspection and verification by the Institute authorities and submit a self-attested copy of each at the time of Document verification from 22nd July 2019 to 26th July 2019
 - Admit Card issued for Part A and Part B Recruitment test.
 - High School/Higher Secondary Certificate/Birth Certificate in proof of date of birth.
 - Qualifying degree (MBBS/BDS/MD/MS/MDS/Ph.D./M.Sc./others.).
 - Valid Permanent/Provisional Registration Certificate issued by MCI or DCI/State Medical or Dental Council.
 - Experience /Relieving and good conduct certificate from the University/Institution last attended.
 - Caste certificate issued as per UP state government rules.
 - EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority as per government rules.
- Selected PDC candidates shall have to pay the fee/dues within the prescribed period, failing which his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- The training programs are full-time and continuous, and private practice in any form after joining the Institute is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this may leave to termination of appointment and cancellation of admission.
- Those who work in departments where there is potential for radiation exposure, shall be compulsorily required to abide by the rules of the Institute's radiation safety cell (in conformity with the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board guidelines).

- e. Candidates admitted to the Institute shall maintain good conduct, perform their duties regularly and abide by the regulations/guidelines of the Institute. Participation in any agitation, protest, strike, etc. is prohibited. Any failure to do so can lead to cancellation of candidature and even termination of appointment.
- f. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the Institute.
- g. No intimation to non-selected candidates will be sent and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- h. These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute, taken from time to time.
- i. The decisions taken by the Director of the Institute in all matters related to the selection of candidates for admission to various courses shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
