Candidates must possess a requisite qualification **RECOGNISED** by the **NMC erstwhile Medical Council of India/NBE before the last date for submission of applications** (except for degrees not covered by Medical Council of India, where the degrees must be recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses).

Final year appearing candidates may also apply in their respective specialty. However, at the time of joining, passing Degree certificate with registration from the recognized body will be required to be submitted, failing which candidate(s) will not be permitted to join and offer of appointment letter will be cancelled.

**Note-For applying PDCC in Resuscitative Emergency Medicine and Neuro Emergency along with other PDCC courses**

Candidates having qualifications MD/DNB Anesthesiology, MD/DNB General Medicine & MS/DNB Orthopedics may also apply for PDCC in Resuscitative Emergency Medicine and Neuro Emergency. However, they need to apply separately for these courses with separate fee if they have already applied for other PDCC in their respective disciplines.

**Reservation:** No reservation is applicable.

**Upper Age:** Upper age limit for eligibility of PDCC is 40 years as reckoned on last date of online application.

**Application Fee:-** (Non-refundable): Payable online as per instructions given in the advertisement.

The application fee for the post of PDCC is Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only (including GST). Additional Bank transaction charge may apply.

- Application fee is non-refundable either in full or in part under any circumstances.
- Applications without the prescribed fee would not be considered and summarily rejected.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Kindly read all details of advertisement, general instructions carefully before applying.
- No application will be received by hand or by post/courier

**Important Instructions:**

1. On-line Application: For online application, candidates will have to provide their mobile number and valid e-mail ID in the prescribed columns, without which their basic registration will not be completed. All the information/instructions will be sent on this mobile number/e-mail id in future.
2. Candidates who are serving in any college/ institution/ hospital as full-time/ part-time/ under service bond/ etc shall obtain a No Objection Certificate from the appropriate authority for application. Their candidature would be rejected if the candidate is unable to produce NOC/ relieving from appropriate authority.
3. If, at any stage, any desired/necessary information is suppressed or misrepresented by the Candidate, his/her candidature can be cancelled and other appropriate action like countervailing etc. can be initiated against him/her.
4. Candidates will have to produce hard copy of their online application, original copies of all certificates in support of all the claims made regarding their candidature in the application and self-attested copies of their certificates, as per the instructions of the institute at the time of interview and/or counseling. The result of written test will be uploaded on institute's website.
5. Candidates are directed to preserve the information (in the form of soft and hardcopy for future reference) rendered at each step of registration/application (eg- registration, fee payment, final submit etc.) while applying online.

**Check List:**

- a) Please complete and arrange your application for future references. (No forms or documents need to be sent to the Institute)
- b) A self-certified copy of matriculation/age proof certificate.

- c) Proof of MD / MS / DNB/DM /MCh/DNB SS course recognized by National Medical Commission of India / State Medical Council and a self – certified NMC recognized MD/MS/DNB/DM/MCh/DNB SS Degree /passing certificate. Qualifications from programs where recognition is pending/in process WILL NOT be entertained and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- d) Candidate with medical degree must submit copies MBBS Medical Registration from NMC or State Medical Council and also registration of MD Degree with council competent bodies.
- e) A ‘No Objection Certificate’ from the current employer (when applicable).

## **STEPS AFTER SUBMITTING APPLICATION**

### **Hall Ticket:**

## **METHOD OF SELECTION:**

### **(a) PDCC Course**

The entrance test will be an objective, MCQ based examination.

- **No Negative marking.**
- In case of tie of candidates securing identical total marks, the older candidate will be ranked higher.
- Counseling details will be updated on website.

## **STEPS AFTER SELECTION**

### **Medical examination**

No candidate will be permitted to join a course/post, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. Withholding information about current or past illness/treatment if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action that may include termination of appointment at any stage.

### **Joining**

If a candidate fails to join the PDCC Courses by the date stipulated in the offer of appointment letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

### **Affidavits required for Joining**

The candidate has to submit two affidavits in standard language regarding-

- 1- The candidate would not be allowed Private Practice
- 2- S/he shall forfeit Rs. 100000/- if leave the seat before completion of tenure.

### **Duties and responsibilities**

Students admitted to PDCC shall simultaneously work as Senior Residents. They will be required to perform such work as may be assigned to them and is necessary in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in emergency services as and when required. The candidate would not be allowed to do private practice.

### **Duration of PDCC:**

- One Year.
- However, the tenure of senior residency shall be extendable annually upto a maximum of three years (including the course tenure) subject to vacancy available in the department and after approval from HOD, Dean & Director.

### **Emolument:**

The emolument of PDC Course candidates will be equivalent to first year Senior Resident as admissible in the Institute.

### **Hostel accommodation**

Accommodation may be provided in the campus, if available.

**Leave entitlement:** As per PDCC Rules.

### **Leaving the course of PDCC:**

- S/he shall pay Rs. 100000/- if leaves the course before completion of tenure.



## **MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS**

- The date, time and venue of examination will be provided on the admit card.
- No TA/DA shall be paid for appearing in the entrance examination or for joining.
- The number of seats/posts advertised may increase/decrease.
- Number of seats/posts indicated in the advertisement for various programs is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- Any attempt on the part of a candidate to suppress facts, to provide false information or to influence selection directly or indirectly will be treated as a disqualification. If evidence of this surfaces after selection, the services may be terminated and admission cancelled, even at that stage.
- Each selected candidate shall have to pay the fee/dues within the prescribed period, failing which his/her admission/appointment shall be cancelled.
- The selected candidates shall need to have present original documents (medical registration, date of birth certificate, certificates of educational qualification, experience and relieving and good conduct certificate from the University/Institution last attended) for inspection and verification by the Institute authorities and submit a self-attested copy of each at the time of joining.
- Qualifications from programs where recognition is pending/ in process will NOT be entertained and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Applicants must possess the eligibility degree/pass certificate before application.
- The training programs are full-time and continuous, and private practice in any form after joining the Institute is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this may leave to termination of appointment and cancellation of admission.
- Those who work in departments where there is potential for radiation exposure, shall be compulsorily required to abide by the rules of the Institutes radiation safety cell,(in conformity with the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board guidelines).
- Senior Residents admitted to the Institute shall maintain good conduct, attend their classes regularly and abide by the regulations/guidelines of the Institute failing which their names are liable to be struck off the rolls of the Institute.
- Participation in any agitation, protest, strike, etc. is prohibited. Candidates not abiding with the supervisions are liable to be terminated.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the Institute.
- No intimation to non-selected candidates will be sent and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute, taken from time to time.

The decisions taken by the Director of the Institute in all matters related to the selection of candidates for admission to various courses shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.

### **Force majeure**
